### 1) The Zululand Historical Museum

### 2) Dlinza Forest Aerial Broadwalk

**This is a wooden walkway above the forest floor. Starting in the forest understory it rises to the leafy canopy as you climb the 20m high viewing tower revealing beautiful views. There is a vast variety of birds, butterflies, trees and flowers. Birding guides booked by appointment.**

### 3) Lake Phobane

**This is a 20 minute drive from Eshowe and is great for water skiing and Bass fishing. Take the Shakaland turn off from the R66 and go past Shakaland itself.**

**Shakaland is a Zulu Cultural Village, which has become part of the Protea Hotel group.
